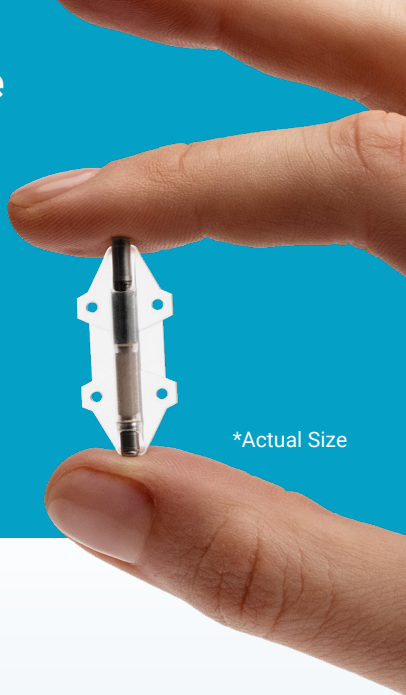

Revi is a miniature implant placed near the ankle, which delivers neuromodulation therapy in a single, outpatient procedure.

The Wearable activates the implant for 30 minutes, on your schedule, when it's convenient for you. As your needs change, your clinician can personalize your therapy through programming adjustments. The Hub wirelessly retrieves therapy data from the Wearable and can provide clinicians visibility into device usage.
